1. Menu & Documentation

This documentation and the DistyMan administrator menu are organized similarly and can be broken into 3 levels:

- 1 **Menus** - only Menus are visible by default until clicked upon
- 2 **Sub-Menus** - sub-menus open and close when their upper Menu is opened
- 3 **Tabs** - The Tabs appear only when their Men/Sub-Menu is opened

There are action buttons that may be needed upon occasion as follows:

- 4 **Cache** - re-builds site cache after content change(s) have been made (bottom-left)
- 5 **Select** - Auto-Fix & Index files rebuilds media cache and is rarely required (bottom-left)
- 6 **Live Mode / Test Mode** - Put the checkout process into test or live mode (top-right)
- 7 **Re-Index** - Rebuilds the cache for the site's search function (top-right)

The site regularly re-builds its cache, using these buttons are typically only required during site updates to force changes to reflect properly on the front end.

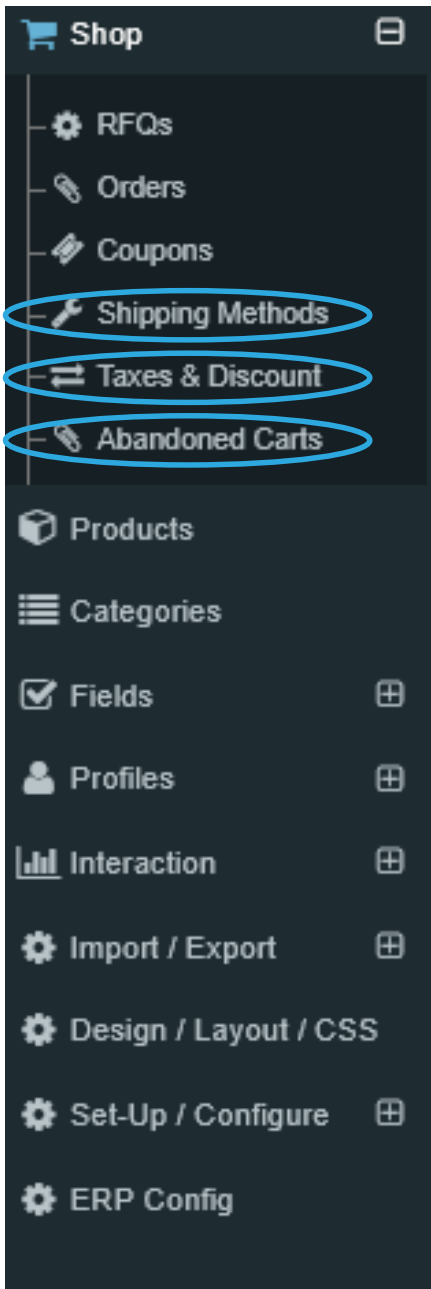

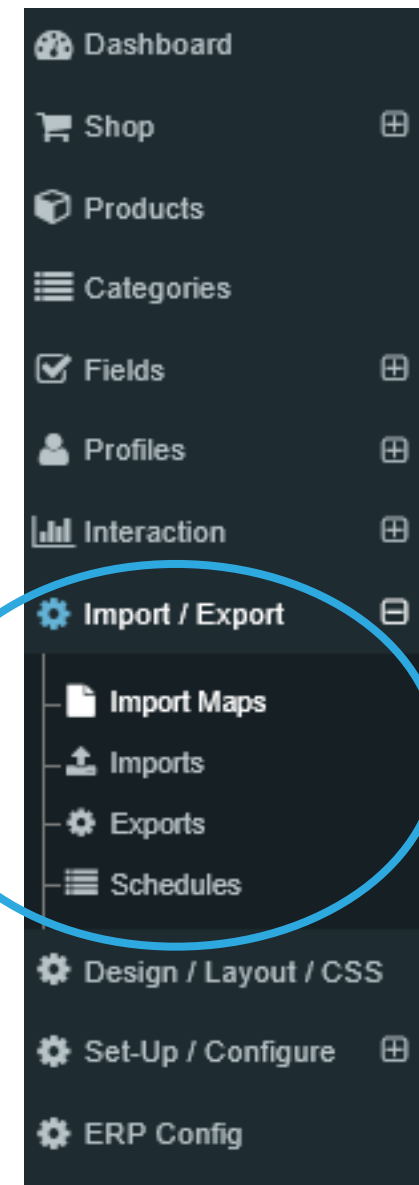

IMPORT MAPS SUB-MENU (PART 4 OF 14)

CSV COLUMNS TAB (1 OF 4)

- Field Section** - you can enable / disable entire field sections to be used within this import map - in products there are 22 field sections. This first "Product" section contains the Unique Key to match existing entries, so it cannot be disabled.
 - Unique Key** - DistyMan can use the Product Title or Product SKU as the identifier of the part data to be imported. In this example, we chose Product SKU.
 - CSV Column Header** - In the Spreadsheet being uploaded, the equivalent field for "Product SKU" is labeled as "Item No" in the top row of the spreadsheet. We double click the DistyMan field to enter the spreadsheet equivalent. We can see in parentheses the DistyMan field name.
- Note, we can use the one field in the datasheet to populate multiple fields in DistyMan. In this example, "Product SKU" and "Product Title" will be populated by the CSV field named "Item No".*
- Enable** - We can disable fields not found in the spreadsheet. The main purpose for this is to allow exporting only the enabled fields and fields sets. For imports, leaving these enabled is not an issue, system will recognize fields are not found and automatically ignore them.

CSV COLUMNS TAB (2 OF 4)

- 1 **Manufacturer Code** - This is the user name of the manufacturer as entered into DistyMan. This field can be disabled, but then you run the risk of updating matching partners from other manufacturers, in which case, both parts would be updated.

In this example, the DistyMan field is "Manufacturer Code" but in the import spreadsheet the field is named "Menu".

This entry allows a default entry, for example adding the Manufacturer name cause no such field exists in the spreadsheet, so in this example entry, all imported parts all belong to the manufacturer user name of TTI.

- 2 **Pricing Type** - DistyMan has standardized on the format called "dynamic", this should either be in the spreadsheet or entered in the default field.

CSV COLUMNS TAB (3 OF 4)

- Dynamic Price / Repeat** - In this example, the site is offering 10 price breaks and has unique labels for the price and breakpoint fields, the DistyMan field equivalent in parentheses.

Note: Only numeric values can be used in these fields, no commas or dollar symbols can be used. Non-numeric values will cause an import failure.

- Prc 1** - The price for this breakpoint (a numeric value, no \$ or commas in the value), decimal points can extend beyond 2 points as needed.

- Dynamic Price Min Quantity** - Renamed to “Prc Brk Min1” to match the spreadsheet. This is the minimum quantity value for this breakpoint price.

Note: If price break quantities are consistent in the importing spreadsheet, you can enter a default value in the blue box.

- Dynamic Price Max Quantity** - Renamed to “Prc Brk Max 1” to match the spreadsheet. This is the max quantity value for this breakpoint price.

Note: If this value is left empty, the system will use a “+” symbol and reflect pricing by min quantities.
